# HINDRANCES TO SALVATION!

## TEXT: Luke 11:52 (With Matt.7:13-14).

#### **INTRO:**

- A. Salvation (Eternal life) is compared to a "gate and way" that we "enter".
- B. Jesus rebuked the Pharisees and lawyers for ...
- 1. Throwing away the KEY to the GATE, not entering in the GATE, and setting up obstacles in the way of those that were entering in (Lk 11:54).
- 2. They had set up many "hindrances" in the way to salvation (v.52).
- a. Being MORE concerned about the "outward" and not considering the "inward (v.39).
- b. "Leaving" the important things of God's "undone" (v. 42).
- c. "Adding" to the meaning of God's law thereby "burdening" the people (v. 46)

# C. This leads me to the thought about "hindrances" to salvation.

- 1. There are MANY "obstacles" that stand in the way of every man's salvation.
- 2. A look at SOME of the "obstacles" that MUST be over come in order for a sinner to be saved.

## I. MAN'S OWN DEPRAVITY IS A HINDRANCE TO SALVATION (Isa. 59:1-2).

#### A. The chief hindrance to a man's salvation is himself!

1. Man's crookedness separates him from God

## B. Man's WILL is SO bent on sinning that he WILL NOT be saved (Isa. 1:5-6; Jn. 5:39-40).

- 1. He WILLS not to be saved.
- 2. He LOVES his sin too much to WILLFULLY give it up (I Tim. 5:6; II Tim. 3:1-4)

## C. Man's sins have such a hold on him that he CANNOT come to God (Jn. 6:44, 65; Jer.13:23).

1. You CANNOT! There is no hope for you IN YOUR SELF!

# D. If a man is ever to be saved HIS depravity MUST be OVERCOME by a power greater than himself!

1. He WILL NOT and CANNOT overcome it himself!

## II. DECEPTIVE WAYS OF SALVATION ARE A HINDRANCE TO SALVATION (Lk. 11:39, 46).

# A. One of the greatest hindrances to TRUE SALVATION is all the FALSE "plans" of salvation.

- 1. Some LEAVE OFF some things Namely SIN & REPENTACE (V.39, 42).
- a. The TRUE nature of the law was to SHOW the sinner his wickedness and helplessness and the Judgment to come (Rom. 3:19-20).
- 2. Some ADD ON some things Namely WORKS (V.46).
- a. Some ADD Baptism . Some "holding out" until the end ...Some "Sabbath-keeping" ...
- b. True salvation means to cease "DOING" and start "TRUSTING"! (Rom. 4:1-8).

## B. Salvation is not in a "plan" or a "road" but IN a MAN - THE GOD-MAN - JESUS CHRIST!

1. If you are "burdened" By self, sin, the law, plans . Jesus says, Come unto ME (MatT. 11:28)!

## III. A DISCIPLE'S DEMEANOR CAN BE A HINDRANCE TO SALVATION.

## A. Our conduct should NEVER stand in the way of sinners being saved.

- 1. We must be careful that our WALK does not hinder the Lost (I Cor. 9:27 Col. 4:4-5; I Pet. 3:14-17).
- a. Our WALK may be used FOR the Salvation of the Lost (I Pet. 3:1-6)

## B. How we REASON with the lost may hinder them being saved (I Pet. 3:15).

- 1. We MUST be READY to give and answer!
- a. We cannot LEAN to our OWN UNDERSTANDING (Proverbs 3:5).
- b. The ONLY way to be ready give a godly answer is to sanctify the Lord God in our heart (I Pet. 3:15; Col. 3:16).

## IV. THE DEVIL IS A HINDRANCE TO SALVATION (Luke 8:12)

# A. The Devil hinders salvation by "stealing" the word out of men's heart.

- 1. He steals the word by casting doubt on it and making light of it.
- a. The devil says, "Hath God said?" (Genesis 3:1) & "IF" (Mt. 4:3, 6).
- b. Is there REALLY ...a God ....a hell ...a Judgment ...?
- 2. He steals the word by adding to it and taking from it (Mt. 4:3-7).
- a. The Fire is still in Hell! Judgment is still coming! God is still on His throne!

## B. Know this - The Devil is a LAIR (John 8:44)!

- 1. What ever your "doubts" may be they are "lies" of the DEVIL!
- a. I am too bad a sinner ... I have been a sinner too long .. I have wasted away my day of grace ...
- b. HEAR God's WORD BELIEVE it and BE SAVED (Isaiah 45:20-22; II Cor 6:2; Acts 16:31).

## CON:

- A. There are GREAT hindrances to salvation!
- B. There are GREAT things that STAND in the way of YOU being SAVED!
- C. Who then can be saved? (Mark 10:26-27).
- D. How then can they be saved?
