# PERSEVERANCE - ANOTHER P' IN OUR TULIPP! GRACE VICTORIOUS "

**TEXT: John 10:27-30** 

#### **INTRO:**

## A. Our TULIPP is spelled with two "P s'."

- 1. We have look at **T**otal depravity *Grace Needed*, **U**nconditional Election- *Grace Conceived*, Limited Atonement *Grace Secured*, and **I**rresistible Grace *Grace Applied*.
- B. We have looked at one of our "Ps", the doctrine of preservation "once saved always saved".
  - 1. What a wonderful doctrine God saves and keeps us safe!
- C. We now look at the second "P" in the doctrines of grace Perseverance, the pursuit of holiness!
  - 1. Preservation and Perseverance Grace Victorious.

#### I. BELIVERS DO PERSEVERE.

### A. What do we mean by perseverance?

- 1. We do not mean "sinless perfection" or that a believers "lives above sin".
- a. The fact is that believers DO NOT and CANNOT live above sin in this life (I Jn 1:8-10).
- 2. What we do mean is that a believer will pursue a course of holiness in his life (Job 17:9; Heb. 12:14; Rom 6:22; III Jn 1:11).
  - a. We mean that believers "keep on keeping on", like a runner in a race (Psalms 37:23-24).
- B. The scripture is full of verses that teach that those who are "truly" born again "WILL" persevere (Jn. 10:27-30; Psalm 1:1-3; II Cor. 2:14).

#### II. REASONS BELIVERS PERSEVERE

## A. Believers persevere because God is working FOR us.

- 1. God's purpose is actively working FOR us (Eph.1:11; Rom. 8:28).
- 2. God is the one who started our salvation and he will see to it that He accomplishes it (Phil. 1:6).
- a. Notice God's active role as our Shepherd "He maketh" "He leadeth (Psa. 23).

## B. Believers persevere because God is working IN us

- 1. Not only is God working for us, He is also working IN us!
- 2. God the Holy Spirit works Faith in is (Eph. 2:8-10; Gal. 5:22-25).
  - a. It is through faith that we are assured that we will overcome (I Jn. 5:4).
- 3. God the Holy Spirit works righteous living in us (Gal 5:22-25; Phil 2:12-14; 8:4, 14-17; Rm 8:1-4).
- a. His work in us proves that we are His (Rom. 8:9-10)!

## C. Believers persevere because GOD is working ON us.

- 1. Not only is God working FOR us and IN us, He is also working ON us.
- 2. God works ON us with his word (Jn. 17:17).
- a. It is through His holy word that we are admonished to press on.
- b. It is through His word that we are warned (Phil 2:12; II Cor. 13:5; II Pet. 1:10).
- 3. God works on us in chastisements (Heb. 12:3-14).
- a. If you are one of God's dear children you cannot be disobedient and get by.
- b. The end of chastisement is "fruit of righteousness".

#### Cons

#### A. All True believers persevere!

- 1. The proof of "eternal security" is found in God's active roll in the life of the believer.
- a. If there is no evidence of God's work there can be no "true" assurance of salvation.
