WHY I DON'T WANT TO GO TO HELL!

TEXT: Psalm 9:15-20

INTRO:

A. Hell is a real place.

- 1. Notice some truths concerning hell that are set forth in this Psalm.
- a. It is a place for the "wicked" and those that "forget" God (Psa. 19:17).
- b. It is a place that men shall be "turned into" (Psa. 19:17).
- c. It is a place that manifests the justice of God (Psa.19:7-8, 16).
- d. It is a place that man's own sins sends him to (Psa. 19:15-16).
- e. The only way of escape is the Mercy of God (Psa. 9:9-10).
- 2. It is a place of everlasting torments, damnation, and punishment (Matt. 23:33; Mk. 9:43-48; Rev. 20:10, 13-15).

B. Word's cannot describe the horrors of the eternal doom of the dammed!

- 1. I cannot make the warring vivid enough! I cannot be too graphic! You cannot be too scarred!
- 2. Hell is real!

C. I can assure you that I do not want to go to hell.

1. I can assure you that I am not going! I can tell you why I don't want to go!

I. I DON'T WANT TO GO TO HELL BECAUSE THE DEVIL WILL BE THERE!

A. The devil is NOT now in hell!

- 1. He is NOW deceiving the nations (Rev. 20:3).
- a. He is behind EVERY falsehood known and promoted by man (Eph. 2:1-2).
- b. The whole world is blinded by his bewitching power (II Cor. 4:4)
- 2. He is NOW an adversary of the people of God (I Peter 5:8-9).
- a. I have had enough of the devil!

B. Praise God! The devil's coming doom is certain (Rev. 20:10).

- 1. Jesus Christ came to destroy the devil (Heb. 2:14-15).
- a. There is coming a day when the devil will be destroyed for ever and ever.

II. I DON'T WANT TO GO TO HELL BECAUSE THERE WILL NOT BE ANY SAVED PEOPLE THERE.

A. Hell is a place for the lost - No matter HOW lost! It is for the lost! (Rev. 20:15; 21:6-8).

- 1. Sinners will be there!
- a. GREAT sinners (Rev. 21:8; Psa. 9:17).
- b. SMALL sinners (Psa. 9:17)- (those that "forget God")
- 2. RELIGIOUS people will be there (Matt. 7:22-23).
- 3. Hell does not "do away" with sin!
- a. Only the blood of Jesus can remit sin (I John 1:7).

B. There will be NO SAVED people in hell (Jn. 3:16, 36).

- 1. Praise God for the promises that God has for His people Eternal life!
- 2. Oh the joy and fellowship of those who are truly saved (I Thess. 1:1-4).
- a. In heaven we will not carry around the weight of sin.

III. I DON'T WANT TO GO TO HELL BECAUSE GOD'S LOVE, GRACE, AND MERCY WILL NOT BE THERE.

A. Oh how I enjoy the love, grace, and mercy of God!

- 1. How thankful I am that God LOVES me (Rom. 8:31-39)!
- a. Electing, saving, keeping LOVE!
- 2. Oh how DEPENDENT I am on His mercy and grace (Titus 3:5-7).

B. But in hell there will not be ANY love, mercy or grace (Matthew 25:46; II Thess. 1:6-9)

- 1. You cannot imagine a place where there is NO love, mercy or grace!
- a. God extends "common mercy" to those on the earth NOW (Matthew 5:45).
- b. Men benefit from the love, mercy, and grace of God who are not objects of such.
- c. But in HELL there is no mercy, love, or grace!

IV. I DON'T WANT TO GO TO HELL BECAUSE THERE WILL NOT BE ANY HAPPINESS, JOY, OR PEACE THERE.

A. I enjoy happiness, love, joy and peace (Psalm 32:1-11).

- 1. The flesh and sin limit my rejoicing NOW!
- 2. Though I know sorrow I will not know it in the life to come.
- a. All the sorrows of this life will be forgotten by the children of God (Isa. 65:13-19)
- b. I am going to a place where there will only be happiness, love, joy, and peace (Rev. 21:3-5).

B. But hell is VOID of HAPPINES, JOY, AND PEACE!

- 1. In hell there is the MEMORY of a wicked life (Luke 16:25).
- 2. In hell there is perpetual torments, weeping, and gnashing of teeth (Luke 16:25; Matt. 25:30; Rev. 20:10; 21:8).
- a. There are not parties, friends, reunions .. in HELL!

V. I DON'T WANT TO GO TO HELL BECAUSE THERE WILL NOT BE ANY HOPE OF GETTING OUT.

A. I am glad I am going to leave this world (Phil. 1:21-23).

- 1. The reason I am glad is because I know where I am going!
- 2. The reason I am glad is because I know HOW and WHY I am going (Gal. 1:4).

B. But those in HELL can never get out!

- 1. Hell is forever (Rev. 14:11; 20:10-15; 21:8)!
- 2. TODAY, NOW, there is HOPE, in Jesus Christ, for EVERY lost man, that will come unto God on God s terms (Heb. 7:25).

VI. I DON'T WANT TO GO TO HELL BECAUSE JESUS WILL NOT BE THERE.

A. Jesus is my ALL in ALL!

- 1. Jesus saved me form my sins.
- 2. He has left me some wonderful promises (Jn. 14:1-3).
- a. I am looking for and longing for HIM (I Jn 3:1-3; Rev. 22:1-7).

B. What is Jesus to you (Rev.22:11-17)?

- 1. Jesus says come! Have you? Will you?
- 2. ARE YOU WITHOUT CHRIST (Eph. 2:12).
- a. To live with out Christ is to die without Christ!
- b. Without Christ means you are without HOPE, without HELP, without LIFE, without a DEFENCEYOU will remain WITHOUT ...IN HELL!

CON:

A. Ye serpents, ve generation of vipers, how can ve escape the damnation of hell? (Matt. 23:33)

1. Only through JESUS CHRIST (DBR)!
